Chairman Galvin called the meeting to order. All recited The Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Villapiano nominated Mr. Stubbs for the office of Secretary/Treasurer. Mr. Theodora seconded the nomination and all voted in favor of Mr. Stubbs being appointed to the office of Secretary/Treasurer.

Mr. Villapiano nominated Mr. Theodora for the office of Assistant Secretary/Treasurer. Mr. Stubbs seconded the motion and all voted in favor of Mr. Theodora being appointed to the office of Assistant Secretary/Treasurer.

c. Local government investment pools which comply with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.1(e) and conditions set by the Division of Local Government Services.

d. New Jersey Cash Management Fund.

e. Repurchase agreements of fully collateralized securities which comply with N.J.S.A. 40A:5-15.1(a).

f. Notes, bonds or other obligations of the United States of America or obligations guaranteed by the United States of America that matures within three hundred ninetyseven (397) days from the date of purchase, and has a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or external factors.

g. Any federal agency or instrumentality obligation authorized by Congress that matures within three hundred ninety-seven (397) days from the date of purchase, and has a fixed rate of interest not dependent on any index or external factors.

h. Bonds, notes or other obligations, having a maturity date not exceeding three hundred ninety-seven (397) days, approved by the Division of Local Government Services for investments by local units (municipalities, counties and fire districts).

i. Bonds, notes or other obligations approved by the Division of Local Government Services for investments by local units (municipalities, counties and fire districts).

4. The Executive Director shall prepare monthly a schedule of investments purchased and redeemed, investment earnings, fees incurred and market value of all investments.

5. The Executive Director shall report to the Authority Members any accounts not earning interest.

WORK SESSION

Executive Director's Report.

The Executive Director advised the members that he received a letter from a resident at 10 Jerome Smith Drive relative to an odor problem. The Director and the Plant Operations Manager both tried to contact him to learn more about his complaint, but were unsuccessful in reaching him. Mr. Kwityn went out to the site and found that the odor was due to ground water. The Director advised the resident about the finding.

Mr. Schmeling, Mr. Bonello and T&M associates met with Town Hall representatives relative to the Asbury Avenue and Longview pump stations. Consideration is being given to putting the pump stations within the existing footprint. T&M sent a proposal to make the changes and said they could accomplish that at a cost of \$7600.00. If it fits within the same footprint it would not be necessary to get approval of a site plan.

There was discussion about the thickening and hauling of sludge.

Director Schmeling reported that there is a meeting tomorrow about 608 West Park Avenue. There are presently two existing houses and the builder will be adding two more.

He also reported that Nobility Crest is adding a second phase to that development.
